Coaches, Managers, Parents and Players,

As the Taylor Sportsplex reopens the staff is making changes to help everyone feel safe. New regulations must be followed to provide attendees a no stress visit.

The Governor's Executive Order 2020-176 allows the Taylor Sportsplex to resume operations. We are a city owned government facility and will strictly abide by the Governor's directives and policies to assure compliance.

This document prepares attendees with the procedures the Sportsplex will utilize. Please review and communicate the information to your coaches and managers before arriving.

The guidelines to reopen can be very challenging and complicated for athletes, coaches, referees, parents and spectators. One of the areas are the visitor compliance to the rules. Sportsplex guests that do not follow the arena policies will be asked to leave the building. In addition, if those in attendance during a practice or game do not follow the rules, the event will be stopped until the requirement(s) are met. If the situation is a continuous non-compliant problem, the event will be cancelled.

To assure a safe and enjoyable visit please follow the procedures below;

- **Please stay home if feeling ill.**
- **Social distancing of 6' is in effect.**
- **Face masks are mandatory at all times in the building, locker rooms and areas of competitive play. Masks are available to purchase if needed.**
- **Please bring your own PPE to the events (masks, hand sanitizer, gloves, etc.) Sanitizer stations will be available at the Sportsplex.**
- **Use the designated building entrances and exits on either Superior or Telegraph road. The north and rear entrances will not be open.**
- **The Concession Stand will not be open. Vending Machines are available with snacks and beverages.**
- **Drinking fountains will not be available. Bring or purchase drinks if needed.**
- **Spectators must stay within assigned areas and practice social distancing.**
- **Gatherings are not allowed in the lobby. Move directly outside the building to avoid congestion and a lack of social distance.**

Soccer League Specific Changes

- Facemasks are **MANDATORY** for every player and spectator, at all times, while at the Taylor Sportsplex. **Masks are required during play.** Anyone that does not follow this rule will be asked to leave the premises.
- Each visitor to the Sportsplex must sign a check-in sheet for Contact Tracing purposes.
- Adult leagues **will not** be allowed any spectators/guests for the near future. Youth leagues will be allowed **one** spectator/guest per player. Guests must also check-in. No exceptions to the rule.
- Teams must arrive no earlier 10 minutes before their game. Do not arrive unnecessarily early for your games, as we will not have the field available until it has been sanitized, and both teams from the prior game have exited the arena. We do not want anyone lingering/gathering in the lobby.
- There will be a 30-minute gap between games. Teams will have 10 minutes to exit the arena after their game. We will also use 10 minutes to sanitize the arena. Teams will have 10 minutes prior to their game to get dressed and warmup.
- We prefer you arrive at least partially dressed in advance, if possible.
- Player showers are not available.
- The North entrance is now employee only. Please utilize the Superior Road or Telegraph Road entrance.
