## SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- Johnson & Johnson is expected to deliver preliminary late-stage trial results for its one-dose COVID vaccine candidate by the end of January. If its jab is proven to be safe and effective, the company aims to deliver at least 1 billion doses by the end of the year.—**CNBC**
- It took about 90 days for the United States to reach its first 2 million cases of coronavirus last year, but it took just 10 days to hit 2.2 million cases in 2021, according to data from Johns Hopkins University. And new infections, hospitalizations and deaths keep soaring. "We're in a dire situation," said Dr. Ashish Jha, dean of the Brown University School of Public Health. "We know how to slow the spread of the virus. We need mask mandates. We need people to really stay at home and avoid any indoor gatherings."—**CNN Health**
- President-elect Joe Biden and his COVID-19 task force are treating the pandemic as a national security-level crisis. A timeline has been laid out for 100 million shots in the first 100 days. As his January 20 swearing-in approaches, sources familiar with the task force's work specify that there will be coordination between the federal and state governments, potential deployment of the National Guard, and the role of private pharmacies are still actively being debated.—**CNN Politics**
