NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND

The City of Taylor will be submitting to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) an Action Plan for FY 2010/11.

A public hearing will be held for the purpose of receiving suggestions, proposals and ideas from interested citizens concerning the proposed use of Federal Housing and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

The public hearing will take place on April 20, 2010 @ 7:00 P.M. at the City of Taylor City Hall, Council Chambers, 23555 Goddard Road, Taylor, Michigan 48180.

The City of Taylor expects to receive \$534,835 during the 2010-11 Federal fiscal year. The proposed activities are listed below:
