SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- In Georgia, there have been concerns with some schools opening since there have been several outbreaks since schools reopening since July 30. Chattooga County Schools Superintendent Jared Hosmer said Monday that since the first two cases of COVID-19 were announced on August 4th, 27 students have been pulled from school by their parents and have enrolled in the virtual program. As of Tuesday, five people (four staff members and one student) in the Dade County school system had tested positive, just days before they were scheduled to go back to class. Face masks will not be required when school starts there.
- Between March and August 7th, the Clark County School District (CCSD) in Las Vegas, Nevada
 has received notifications of 101 confirmed COVID-19 adult cases and 22 confirmed student
 cases. When a positive test case impacts a CCSD facility, the district says it will initiate a
 disinfectant cleaning protocol for that facility in compliance with CDC recommendations.
- It took six months for the world to reach 10 million confirmed cases of COVID-19. It took just over six weeks for that number to double. The worldwide count of known COVID-19 infections climbed past 20 million, with more than half of them from just three countries: the U.S., India and Brazil, according to the tally kept by Johns Hopkins University. The average number of new cases per day in the U.S. has been running high at over 54,000, almost 59,000 in India and nearly 44,000 in Brazil.
- The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and Department of Defense (DoD) announced an agreement with Moderna, Inc. to manufacture and deliver 100 million doses of the company's COVID-19 vaccine candidate. The federal government will own these vaccine doses. Moderna will manufacture the vaccine doses while clinical trials are underway. Manufacturing in parallel with clinical trials expedites the traditional vaccine development timeline and builds toward the U.S. government's Operation Warp Speed goal to begin delivering safe and effective vaccines to the American people by the end of the year. If the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) authorizes use as outlined in agency guidance, the vaccine doses would be distributed and used as part of a COVID-19 vaccination campaign.
